

that they attended by a competent Surveyor, allot to Mrs. Grumpler late widow of Austin Edwards one third of the Lands (regarding being her to value) whereof Austin Edwards died purg'd for life, and that they sell to the highest bidder on a credit of six months the other two thirds together with the fee simple interest in the third which is to be allotted as above directed, and after receiving money enough in cash to pay the cost of the lease, take of the purchaser seven books of equal amounts, and assign me to Tyler Edwards, and right of his wife, one to Gray Edwards, one to Collins Barnes guardian of child of Randolph Edwards, one to Anthony Vaughan,wright of his wife, one to John Morris in right of his wife onto William Edwards and the other to Eliza Dardou in right of his wife, and report their proceedings to the Court in order to a final decree.

The Court doth assign William H. Webb guardian to Eliza, Jane, Nancy and Catharine Bryant orphans of Jonathan Bryant deceased, and therewith the said William H. Webb together with Seth & Williams, Lemuel Roberts and John Cobb his securities interested in and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars with condition according to Law.

An account of John R. Chamberlips guardianship of Rebecca Nurman was returned and ordered to be recorded.

James Scott having obtained an attachment against the estate of Gray Edwards who has removed or absconded out of the County privately, for the sum of One hundred & eighty dollars with interest thereon from the 18th day of February 1836 due by note, also the further sum of Sixteen dollars & 60^c due by note bearing date 18th October 1836 with interest thereon, and the Sheriff having made return that he had executed the said attachment on one land occupied by Benjamin Vick for two hundred and twenty three dollars 55^c bearing date the 19th day of June 1837, Benjamin Vick receipt for goods amounting to one hundred and five dollars 75^c, to be accounted for by said Vick - Five notes against Solomon Johnson amounting to forty eight dollars 55^c - One account against Fielding Mahone for thirty seven dollars 57^c/100 - a small lot of dry goods, part of a barrel of sugar, part of a barrel of brandy, part of a chest of tea, some candles, part of a keg of powder, some spars & paper, a few articles of ready made clothing - a cake of wax, a lot of paper, a few rolls of medicine, a table, several chairs, a chest, one clock, 2 potters, a lot of iron ware, a Jersey waggon, a two horse waggon, a cart and wheel, and one 1800 bushel, part of a keg of salts, a bridle and martingale - The above named Solomon Johnson, Benjamin Vick and Fielding Mahone have been summoned by note the next County Court as garnishers. I have also given notice to William Edwards, Allen Edwards and Abram Riddick by summoning them to the next Court to answer to the amount due from them to Gray Edwards. The foregoing attachment came to hand and was executed at eleven O'clock June 22nd 1839. Whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court the said attachment is continued till the next Court.

Anthony Vaughan having obtained an attachment against the estate of Gray Edwards who hath privately absconded, for One hundred dollars due by note with interest thereon from the 18th day of May 1836, also forty dollars by note due the 6th day of October 1836
