For reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that Benjamin Griffin pay over to Thomas and Jacob Foster the balance due from the said Griffin upon the settlement of his administrative account in John Foster's estate.

Ordered that John Whitehead, Edward Beaton, Richard Jackson and Benjamin Waller or any three of them let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of Thomas' bridge over the flat Swamp, receive the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Thomas Lawrence, James Harris, Nathaniel Barnes, Thomas McDade, William Holt, James Elchington, Samuel M Pond and Harriet D Moore who were appointed Constables in this County at the last Term, this day took the oaths prescribed by law and severally entered into bond with security as the law directs, which bonds were severally acknowledged by the obligors thereon named and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the Sheriff summons the acting Justices of the peace of this County to November Court next to take into consideration the propriety of purchasing some more Multiculus trees for the Glades of this County.

Ordered that the Sheriff summons the Justices of this County to November Court next to take into consideration the propriety of erecting two small bridges, one near South quay and the other near the Rail Road in this County.
