This day came the parties by their attorneys who being fully heard, and it appearing to the Court that the Defendant hath had legal notice of this motion, it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff may have execution against the goods and chattels of the defendant where the Judgment heretofore rendered in this Court, the defendant having subsequently to the rendition of the judgment taken the oath of insolvency -

Richard Darden is appointed surveyor of the road from Deeks Swamp to the Cypress bridge in the road of Hardy Soyner ceased and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Holt examine State and settle the account of Thomas Lewis guardianship of Thomas Simon and report the same to Court with any matters specially stated or referred by himself or which he may be required to state.

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the Sheriff Committee of Jacksons Parish pay over to Martin Packford widow of said Jacksons, the balance due upon the settlement of his trusteeship as Commissioner of said Parish for the support of said widow and children.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Holt examine State and settle an account of John Lewis guardianship of Caroline and William Melnick and report the same to the Court with any matters specially stated or referred by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that Littlejohn A. Edwards be appointed special Commissioner to examine and adjust an account of Benjamin Deacons Curatorship of William L. Edwards estate and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Hope Ferguson deceased who made oath and together with her husband and Benjamin Soyner his decedent entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him to administer on the estate of his deceased wife Lucy Ferguson in due form.
