

Ordered that John W. North administrator of the Estate of Deborah de^d renders before Masters Commissioners both an account of the transactions of said Deborah as late Executor of said testator and that the said Commissioners settle the same and make report thereof to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

On the motion of James D. Maysburg Sheriff of this County William M. Corbett is permitted to qualify as his deputy during sickness and afterwards the said Corbett takes the several oaths prescribed by law. The Court being of opinion that the said Corbett is a man of honesty fidelity and good demeanor.

Samuel Kelle Commissioner of this revenue certified to the Court that there were no Ordinary keepers or merchants within his district who have failed to comply with the law.

Ordered that Lillie A. Edwards be appointed Commissioner to make settle and adjust an account of Benjamin Griffins transactions as Comanche of the estate of John Correll deceased and that he make report thereof to Court.

This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court with order, adjudge and decree that Stephen Maudslough, James D. Maysburg and L. A. Archbold be appointed Commissioners any two of whom may act, that they after ascertaining the time and place of sale, do sell to the highest bidder on a credit of six months the lands whereof Edward Edwards died seized and after receiving money enough to pay the cost of this decree take of the purchaser one bond for one fourth part of the amount of sale, which they will assign to Mrs. Grampson late widow of Edward Edwards in lieu of her third, and for the residue take seven bonds of equal amount and assign one to Tyler Edwards in right of his wife, one to James P. Barnes attorney for Ed^d & Williams in right of Garry Edwards, one to William Barnes guardian of the child of Randolph Edwards, one to Anthony Vaughan in right of his wife, one to John Moore in right of his wife, one to William Edwards and the other to Elshie Garden in right of his wife, and report their proceedings to the Court in order to a final decree.
