This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read and was argued by counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth order, adjudge and decree that Stephen Marbaugh, James D. McSpedding and L. D. Aribson be appointed Commissioners, any two of whom may act, that they after advertising the time and place of sale, to sell to the highest bidder on a credit of six months the lands whereof Jacob Edwards died seized, and after receiving money enough to pay the costs of this decree, sake of the purchase one bond for one fourth part of the amount of \$100, which they will assign to Mrs. Grumpler late widow of Jacob Edwards in lieu of her thirds, and for the residue take seven bonds of equal amounts and assign one to Taylor Edwards in right of his wife, one to James P. Finch attorney for Seth C. Williams in right of Gray Edwards, one to Collins Barnes guardian of the child of Randolph Edwards one to Anthony Vaughan in right of his wife, one to John Moore in right of his wife, one to William Edwards and the other to Elisha Gordon in right of his wife, and report their proceedings to the Court in order to a final decree.
