On the motion of Matthew Hills who made oath and together with Allen Edwards and John Rowe his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Mason Syner de^d in due form.

Ordered that Nathan Turner Thomas Hunley William Harris and Joseph Syner among three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do a return of all the personal estate of Mason Syner de^d and return the appraisement under their hands.

The Registers of Isaac Nichols Susan Newsum and Amey Newsum free negroes were examined and certified to be truly made.

For reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that John Scarborough Jr. guardian to the person of James Robert de^d pay to the widow of said James Robert the amount in his hands as the guardian for the purpose of supporting and clothing said orphan.

On the motion of John Little who produced the Sheriff's receipt for the sum ordered by law and the William J. Sebrell his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred and fifty dollars conditioned as the law directs a license is granted him to keep an ordinary in Jerusalem till May Court next the Court being of opinion that the said Little is a person of good character and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming.

On the motion of John Le Turner and Selah Ellsworth against William Holt executor of the estate of Holt for counter security. This day came the said parties by their attorneys who being sworn it is ordered that the said Holt give the said Turner and Ellsworth good counter security for the said purpose to be in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars and conditioned as the law directs and thereupon the said William Holt with Mills Epps and Bennett & Whitfield his securities entered into a bond made payable to the said John Le Turner and Selah Ellsworth according to law.
