

But this execution may be discharged by the payment of Thirty Two dollars and Twenty Cents with legal interest thereon from the 8th day of May 1809 till paid and the Costs.

Ordered that Sampson E. Rice, Danwell Bryant, Williams T. Bryant and James P. Cook or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Mary T. Pope dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

The Last Will and Testament of Elizabeth Ferguson dec^d was proved by the oath of Little Anderson and Robert S. Barnes the subscribing Witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. Thomas W. Worrell the executor therein named appeared in Court and refused to take the oath before the Court of the execution thereof. On the motion of Sarah Ferguson dec^d's next of kin and together with Robert S. Barnes and Thomas W. Worrell his securities entered into and acted as bond in the penalty of Two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs and granted for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said Elizabeth Ferguson and her said will annulled in due form.

Ordered that Robert S. Barnes, Thomas W. Worrell, and Benjamin Whitfield being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Elizabeth Ferguson dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of the estate of John P. P. P. dec^d was returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Adam Wolfson against James Edwards administrator of Joseph Edwards dec^d for counter security. This day came as well the said Wolfson by his Attorney as James Edwards in his proper person who being heard it is ordered that the said James Edwards give the said Adam Wolfson good Counter Security, and the said Edwards refuse to give the said security it is ordered that the powers and duties of the said Edwards as administrator as aforesaid be revoked, and that the unadministered estate of the said Joseph Edwards be committed to the hands of James D. Hopkings Sheriff of the County of administration according to Law.

Ordered that James W. Murfee, Wells Murfee and Stephen Murdough or any two of them shall to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the large bridge over Hopkings River, receive the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Littleton R. Edwards be appointed Special Commissioner to State and adjust an account of James W. Packers administration on Temperance Paines estate and that he make report thereof to Court.
