

But this execution may be discharged by the payment of Thalry Five Dollars and twenty five cents with legal interest thereon from the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May 1809 till paid and the costs.

Ordered that Sampson & Rose, Burnell Bryant, Williams & Bryant and James Cook or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Mary Pope deceased and return the appraisement under their hands.

The last Will and Testament of Elizabeth Ferguson deceased was proved by the oaths of Little Anderson and Robert Barnes the subscribing witnesses and ordered to be recorded. Thomas B. Worrell the executor therein named appeared in Court and refused to take upon him the burden of the execution thereof. On the motion of Sarah Ferguson who made up and together with Robert Barnes and Thomas B. Worrell his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs that said grantee for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said Elizabeth Ferguson and her said will annexed in due form.

Ordered that Robert S. Barnes, Thomas B. Worrell and Benjamin Whitfield being duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Elizabeth Ferguson deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of the estate of Talitha Relation deceased are returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Adam Wolford against James Edwards administrator of Talitha Relation deceased for Counter Security. This day came as well the said Wolford by his Attorney Robert Edwards in his proper person wheling heard. It is ordered that the said James Edwards give the said Adam Wolford good Counter Security, and the said Edwards shall give the said security it is ordered that the powers and duties of the said Edwards administrator as of record be revoked, and that the unadministered estate of the said Joseph Edwards be committed to the hands of James A. Mapenburg Sheriff of the County administrator according to Law.

Ordered that James W. Murphy, Wells Murphy and Stephen A. Murphy or two of them be let to the lowest undertaker the repair of the large bridge over the Virginia River, receive the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Colletus R. Edwards be appointed Special Commissioner to State and adjust an account of James W. Parker's administration on Temperance Perkins estate that he make report thereof to Court.
