A Deed of Trust between Joseph Darden of the first part William D'Court of the second part and Nathaniel Francis of the third part was acknowledged by the said Darden, D'Court and Francis to be their act and deed and ordered to be recorded -

On Jan 18th John I Drake who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer the complaint of Julia Scarborough against him for a breach of the peace, appeared in discharge of his recognizance. Whereupon the said Julia Scarborough being sworn and examined and the said Drake fully heard. It is the opinion of the Court and accordingly ordered that the said John I Drake give security for keeping the peace for the term of one year from this day himself to be bound in the sum of One hundred dollars with two securities in the sum of fifty dollars each, and that the said Drake pay the costs of this prosecution. And therefore the said John I Drake with James W Parker and John James his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto David Campbell Esqr. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia and his successors in Office, that is to say, the said John I Drake in the sum of one hundred dollars and his said securities in the sum of fifty dollars each to be levied of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements, and to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that the said John I Drake shall keep the peace and be of good behavior towards the Commonwealth and all its citizens more especially towards the said Julia Scarborough for the term of one year from this day then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

Ordered that Master Commissary Cobb examine, state and deliver an account of Elizabeth Hines guardianship of George and Cornell late slaves and make report thereof to Court with any other specially stated demand pertinent by himself or which he may be required to State.

A Deed of bargain and sale from William Holt and Ann his wife to John M Neal was acknowledged by the said William Holt to be his act and deed and together with a certificate thereon annexed of the former examination and acknowledgement of the wife ordered to be recorded.
