And thereupon the said John S. Drake with James W. Parker and John James his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto David Campbell Esqr. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia and his successors in Office, that in day, the said John S. Drake in the sum of One hundred dollars and his said securities in the sum of fifty dollars each to be levied of their respective goods and chattels, lands and Tenements, and to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said John S. Drake shall keep the peace and be of good behavior towards the Commonwealth and all its Citizens more especially towards the said Julia Scarborough for the Term of one year from this day, then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
