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The last Will and Testament of Molly Jenkins deceased was proved by the oaths of Thomas Joyner and Matthew Drake the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of James Williams the executor therein named who made oath and together with Anthony H Howell and Thomas Lawrence his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a prelat thereof in due form.

Ordered that Joseph Joyner, Thomas Joyner, Patrick Rowe and John Drake or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Molly Jenkins dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Sarah Cam orphan of John Cam dec^d with the approbation of the Court made oath of Edward Beaton for her guardian who together with Nathaniel Frances and Richard Porter his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

In open Court James Williams Esq^r who made oath that he was well acquainted with Robert Kirby dec^d formerly of Southampton County who died somewhere from 25 to 30 years ago in the said County of Southampton. The defendant further states that the said Robert Kirby was in the army of the Revolutionary War and served in the said army about four years and did not leave the service until the end of the War. The said Kirby was at Yorktown in battle at the capture of Cornwallis. He left the County of Southampton under the command of Captain James Gray and went first to the North. This defendant was never with the said Kirby in any engagement other than that at Yorktown. The defendant further states that the said Kirby had the following children his sole heirs at his death, Isaac Kirby, Sally and Peggy and one son called William Kirby that the female aforesaid are now 20 years without issue, and the said William Kirby died in October last leaving Benjamin Kirby, Isaac Kirby or Martha Kirby, and Anna Kirby his children. Martha is the wife of Benjamin Andrews, Anna is dead without issue and Benjamin is still living in Southampton County, State of Virginia. And that there is no widow of the said Robert Kirby now living.
