On consideration thereof and by Consent it is decreed and ordered that the sale and decision aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and forever binding between the parties and the two bonds returned with the report are ordered to be lodged with the Clerk till the further order of the Court.

Ordered that John Baytown, John Brown, Joseph B. Counsel and William Woodard or any three of them in conjunction with the Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Sale of Va. let the repairs of Fowells bridge receive the same when completed and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Jeremiah Cobb, James D Maffenberg and James D French do examine in Clerks Office of this Court and report to the Court what repairs are necessary to be done to the same and what additional expenses if any are necessary.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
