

Upon the petition of Davis Bryant and Henry Williams for leave to erect a water grist mill on the lands of the said Bryant on the North side of the Cypress Swamp between the mills of Allen and Rockells at an old mill site in this County. This day came the said Davis Bryant and Henry Williams by their attorney and the Sheriff returned an inquest taken from and to the west of ad quod damnum awarded at the last Term, which inquest is in substance as follows. "By virtue of the annexed writ of ad quod damnum we William H. Cutler Esq.

Says the jury Swore and charged by Williams & Gibrell Deputy of James L. Maypole  
Sheriff of Guilford County agreeable to law, do say that by allowing Davis Bryant and  
Henry Williams to hold ten feet of water provided it don't come within his hundred yards  
of Le Rockells mill, but provided it do interfere with Le Rockells mill to be done  
so far as not to interfere with Rockells mill, we agree to allow Start the sum of four  
damages, Robert Williams twelve dollars & one acre land belonging to William Davis in  
abundance, at four dollars. We further report that the health of the neighbourhood will not be  
annoyed, nor any of their houses, offices, Cottages or gardens or orchards will be injured  
the passage of fish be obstructed, and that the mill be of great publick utility. Given  
our hands and seals this 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1829. W. H. Cutler Esq., Demott & Co.

the prospectors of the area of land located by the jury and the prospectors of the land given  
to damages be summoned to the next Court to show cause, if any they can, why  
they should not have leave to erect the said mill and dam.
