

Ordered that Elisha Darden, Willis W Lawrence, James T. Hare, and William S. Croft or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Jesse S. Darden dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

A writing bearing date September 20th 1821 purporting to be the last will and Testament of Stephen Munday dec^d was produced in Court and there being no subscribing witnesses thereto William C. Parker, Joseph T. Cloud, William J. Schell and Robert Richs were sworn who severally depose and swear that they are acquainted with the hand writing of the said Stephen Munday, and that they truly believe the body of the said writing as well as the signature thereto to be in the hand writing of the said Stephen Munday. Whereupon it is ordered that the said writing be recorded as such for the last Will and Testament of the said Stephen Munday dec^d and in the return of James D. Wagoner the executor therein named who made oath and together with Robert Richs, Allen Edmon and William Briggs his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Ten thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted here for obtaining a probat thereof in due form, liberty being reserved for the executor therein named to be joined in the said probat when she thinks fit.

Ordered that James W. Munfee, Joseph S. Munday and William Sule being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Stephen Munday dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

A deed of bargain and sale from Adams Jones and Charity his wife to Solomon Thomas was acknowledged by the said Adams Jones to be his act and deed and together with a Certificate annexed of the proper execution and acknowledgment of the wife ordered to be recorded.

An Inventory and Appraisement of the estate of Mary D. Hunt dec^d was returned and ordered to be recorded.

An account of sales of the estate of Mary D. Hunt dec^d was returned and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Bell examine State and settle an account of William S. Wynns administrator in the estate of Elizabeth Porter dec^d and report the points (if any) with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.
