

The above is a plan of the parcels of land set apart to the heirs of Genl. Beale deceased containing by recent survey 114¹/2 acres which we have divided as is above represented. At 1st Containing 50 acres to W^t Foster for life and the remainder to Sally Foster as per annexed Survey which is bounded as follows: Beginning at a Chestnut Stake thence N 8° W 50 poles to 10 backwater River to a Postumous Line concur thence A 8° and S²° thence up the river the various courses thereof 75 ft to a large Cypress in the mouth of the Caddo got thence S 25° E 30° ft to a Blk. gum thence S 87° E 2° ft to a Blk. gum thence S 8° E 26° ft to a Blk. gum at the Hill thence S 25° W 10° ft to a post oak thence S 57° W 46° ft to a post oak, thence S 42° W 42° ft to a large dead pine coner of this tract and Daniel Foster thence S 74° E 8° ft to a Blk. jack, thence N 69° E 10° ft to Blk. jack thence S 77° E 24° ft to a Blk. jack, thence S 55° E 40° ft to a Pine, thence N 35° E 10° ft to a small corner of John Cobb and Mrs Foster in this line S 50° E 46° ft to a small pine & L 5° E 58° ft to an apple tree stump in the garden thence S 25° E 3° ft to the beginning S 2° E W^m Daughtry and Polly Foster containing 65 acres which is bounded as follows: Beginning at the said Chestnut Stake thence N 8° W 50° ft along a line of posts and marked trees to a Postumous line at the river a new course of the stream, thence down the river the various courses thereof 155 ft to a gut, the old line of Mr. Foster thence along the Bluff, the old line W^m Foster the various courses thereof 90 ft to the river at the upper end of the old stream.
