the balance upon a credit of six months, the purchaser to execute six bills with approved security,  
one of which they are to assign to Allan D. Mungo in his own right, one to William Williams  
in right of his wife and the other four the guardians of the infant children respectively and  
report to the Court in order to a final decree -
