

Prigge, or any three of them, who are hereby appointed commissioners for the purpose, powerd
 To divide the slaves in the bill mentioned, namely, Nathan, Dolphin, Sife, Mills, Sam-
 uel, Cornelius, Rezzetta, Charlotte, ally, Nancy, Xanyssa, Garrison, Sarah, Maria, Marga-
 ret, Jerry, Fanny, Morgannna and Peggy, being a portion of the slaves of which Henry
 Turley died seised, in the following proportions, that is to say, that they set apart and
 allot $\frac{375}{1000}$ part of the same (to wit, three tenths seven hundredths and seven thousandths of the
 value of the whole) to the guardian of the infant complainant William D Turley; a like
 proportion to the guardian of the infant complainant John W Turley; $\frac{125}{1000}$ part of the
 same (to wit, one tenth two hundredths four thousandths of the value of the whole) to the
 defendant Edwards Bulls in right of his wife Rebecca; $\frac{450}{1000}$ part of the same (to wit,
 no tenths three hundredths and five thousandths of the value of the whole) to the guardian
 of the infant complainant Anna R Bulls, a like proportion to the defendant Edwards
 Bulls in his own right, and $\frac{625}{1000}$ part of the same (to wit, no tenths six hundredths and
 two thousandths part of the value of the whole) to the guardian of the infant complainant
 James F Bulls; and that they make report of their proceedings with the view to a
 final decree.

 which his widow Matthew Mellekin died seised and possessed upon such a credit as
 he shall deem reasonable to the highest bidder and the proceeds of said sale after
 defraying all necessary expenses pay out as follows, dividing the same into three equal
 parts - Viz. One third part to Sarah James Mellekin or her guardian, one third to
 the guardian of Matthew Mellekin, and one third part reserve for himself as the por-
 tion of his wife Mary, and make return to this Court how he has executed the
 same -
