And the said Ordy Adams is remanded to jail until the said security be given.

For reasons appearing to the Court Ordered that the Overseers of the Poor or any two of them in the upper or lower district of Newbury Parish bind Polly Anne Day a poor girl to Thomas Hargrave according to Law.

Ordered that proper process be issued against the persons this day presented by the grand jury returnable here to the next quarterly Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning nine o'clock.
