For reasons appearing to the Court, it is ordered that Henry B. Vaughan, Benjamin Lamb, Henry Pelham and Waley Weyant or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose, do view the road running from near the farther bridge on the South side of the testimony near Ipswich, through the Indian land to the road leading from the bridge roads to Camp bridge, and report to the Court the convenience and inconvenience that will result as well to individuals as to the public of the said road should be established a public highway.
