Hector M. Murphy orphan of Barnwell Murfee deceased with the approbation of the Court made oath before Eliza C. Ide for her guardian who together with Lewis Merrill and Thomas W. Merrill his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

The Court doth adjudge Nathaniel Francis guardian to Mary Williams and John Murfee Jr. & John Murfee Jr. who together with John Brumley and Peter Edwards his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Six thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

The Court doth adjudge Penning J. Smith guardian to Harrison Parker orphan of Harrison Parker deceased who together with Garrison Colton and William Hanson his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.
