On the motion of Eldridge & Atkinson who made oath and together with John G. Nicholson and Charles Hart his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Samuel Hart dec'd with his will annexed in due form.

On the motion of Samuel Drury setting forth he is bound in this Court as security to John H. Stewart as guardian of Joseph Nicholson and praying the Court for relief. The said John H. Stewart being here in Court and being fully heard it is ordered that the said John H. Stewart give right to Samuel Drury good common security, the bond for which is to be in the sum of one thousand dollars and conditioned according to law, and that the said John H. Stewart be also to pay the costs of this motion. And thenceforth the said John H. Stewart with James H. Stewart and John A. Atkinson his securities, herein named, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of one thousand dollars and conditioned according to law.
