Ordered that the accounts of William Davis amounting to two dollars and eighty five cents be paid to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination and payment.

On the motion of Eldredge C. Atkinson who made oath and together with John E. Nicholson and Charles Hart his secretaries entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration in the estate of Samuel Hart dec^d with his will annexed in due form.

On the motion of Samuel Drury setting forth he is bound in this Court as executor for the said Stewart as guardian of Charles Nicholson and praying the Court for relief. The said John W. Brown being here in Court and being fully heard. It is ordered that the said John W. Brown give to the said Samuel Drury good counter security, the bond for which purpose is to be in the penalty of one thousand dollars and conditioned according to law, and that the said John W. Brown be allowed the costs of this motion. And therefore the said John W. Brown with James W. Stewart and James A. W. Newman his secretaries, here in Court, entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of the premises and conditioned according to Law.
