On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Thomas H Williamson, Thomas G. Williams and Edwin R. Eland, or any three of them, be appointed Commissioners to check the children of Daniel Myrick are entitled to as to their share in the administration of Algernon & Myrick dec^d's one fifth part in value of said slaves. And the said Commissioners further divide such Algernon part into five equal shares and allot to Phoebe A Myrick one fifth, to Pauline C. Elizabeth C. Delilah C and Emma R Myrick each one fifth, and if the said subdivision cannot be effected in kind, then the same may be sold, and divide the proceeds as the slaves are distributed to be divided. That the same be sent to Court in order to a final decree.

Ordered that Nicholas M. Schell and Sethlow P. Edwards be appointed Commissioners to the Court undertake the repair of the jail of this County, and when the same is repaired to make report thereof to Court.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Molly Atkinson dec^d ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Temple A. Busham who produced the Sheriff's receipt for the same and with Thomas & Jones his attorney entered into and acknowledged a bond reciting he is granted him to keep an Ordinary at the Crossroads in this County till May 1st next, paying of opinion that the said Busham is a man of good character and will not run away or garnish.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Ishmael Simon and James B. Murphy the administrator and ordered to be recorded.
