Additional Morris orphan of Henry Morris deceased with the approbation of the Court made choice of James H. Pond for his guardian, and thereupon the said James H. Pond with Robert Drury, Samuel M. Pond, John A. Ward, Silas H. Worth and Patrick D. Hollings his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty five hundred dollars conditioned according to Law.

In the action of Howell Harris who made oath and together with Alexander Myrick and Benjamin Drury his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs each party is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Algernon S. Myrick dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Thomas H. Williamson, James Harris and Thomas Turner being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Algernon S. Myrick deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that Master Commissioners shall examine State and settle an account of Thomas H. Worrell's administration on the estate of Lewis Worrell dec^d and report the same to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.
