This day came the parties by their Counsel and the Commissioners appointed under the intestate's decree made in this cause at November Term last, to allot to the plaintiff Charlotte one third of the land and slaves of which Robert T Musgrave dec^d died seized & possessed for life, this day made a report which is ordered to be received and is in these words to wit: Pursuant to an order from the Worshipful Court of Southampton City bearing date November Day 1823 and accounts annexed thereto the undersigned Commissioners proceeded as directed to divide all the slaves belonging to the estate of Robert T Musgrave dec^d with the exception of a negro man named Arthur which slave the said Musgrave estate holds only a life interest consequently at the death of 1824 Nathaniel Edwards the said master Arthur will descend to the heirs of Edmund Bunker dec^d having thus executed the parties desired that in the said slave should be placed that each may draw an equal interest agreeable to their respective legal claims knowing no mode to be more equalled we have taken no notice of him in the allotment further than to place him in the hands of Josiah T. Lee Administrator of Robert T Musgrave dec^d and also acting guardian for the orphans with the view that he shall annually hire and sell such interest as the estate holds in said slave shall terminate and retain two thirds of the amount of hire for the benefit of the orphans and the remaining third pay over to Charlotte Lee as her dower interest - as it may be considered that we have not strictly attended to your decree we respectfully ask your consideration and endorsement respecting the said slave - The valuation and allotment is as below stated.

That Arthur to be hired out and proceeds to be distributed as above stated.
