On the motion of Henry Pitting. Ordered that he be exempt from the payment of taxes in future for his slave Leonard he being aged and infirm.

On the motion of Joseph Stanton Ordered that he be exempt from the payment of taxes and levies for his slave Sally she being aged and infirm.

For reasons appearing to the Court. It is ordered that the Overseers of the Poor in the application of Nathaniel Parrott or any two of them bind James and Nicholas two free negro boys to William W. Bailey until they respectively arrive to twenty one years of age - that the Overseers of the Poor covenant with the said Bailey that he pay to the masters of the said negro boys the sum of twenty two dollars and fifty cents per year for said James and Nicholas during the apprenticeship except the last year which amount for last year are to be paid to the said apprentices.

Accounts of William Atwell guardianship of Celiza Bryant James Bryant Mary Boy and Catharine Bryant were returned and ordered to be recorded.

This day came the parties by their Counsel and the Comptroller's report, and by the instruction given in this case at December Court 1858 to make the division and allotment of the land mentioned this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words: In pursuance to the annexed decree bearing date Dec Court 1858 to wit: that Celizabeth Pierce the widow of Peter J. Pierce one third of the lands of which the said Peter J. Pierce died seized as also to allot to the said Celizabeth Pierce as administratrix the one third share of the estate of said *de* as her report. That she deceased held two parcels of land, the first tract containing by the annexed plat made by the Comptroller's survey and called in by us for this purpose 121 acres and the other tract is comprised from a plat made by the Comptroller, was held for two hundred and twenty eight acres and in dividing the value of the said two tracts of land, we agreed to assign to the said Celizabeth Pierce the one tract containing 121 acres as her share. We also have allotted to her the following negroes to wit: Bartilla a Neg. Angelina, and Manerva and child valued at \$1200. and \$3200. Respectfully Submitted - J. B. Dick, C. B. K. R.
