This day this cause came on to be heard upon the bill, answer and exhibit, and was argued by Counsel. Whereupon the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Jeremiah Holt be appointed Commissioner, authorized to sell, reasonable notice having been given for time and place, and upon the same Terms, as the lands belonging to John Denegre and Mary D. his wife are to be sold, the lands of which John Denegre died seized, and the proceeds thereof after deducting all necessary expenses, be divided into four equal parts, giving to James Denegre one fourth part, to Francis P. Biddle one eighth part, and to the guardians of Mary D. Denegre and William Oris Denegre one eighth part.
