This day this cause came on to be heard upon the bill, answer and exhibits and was argued by Counsel. Whereupon the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Hermanns Calt be appointed Commissioner authorized to sell the maiden land of which Mary B Denegre late widow and relict of John Denegre died seized at the same time and upon the same terms, as the lands belonging to the estate of John Denegre dec<sup>d</sup> advertised to be sold in accordance with the provisions of his will, and that the proceeds after deducting all necessary expenses be divided into four equal parts and pay over as follows, one fourth to James Denegre, one fourth to Francis J Dells in right of his wife Emma, and one fourth over to the guardian of Mary B & William Orris Denegre, and should there be no guardian return the proportions to the Court for its further action, and report how he has executed the same

A Deed of bargain and sale from Hannah Barnett, Matilda Barnett and Polly Barnett to Davis Vick was proved by the oath of Augustus Pope, William Vick and John Vick the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.
