

Ordered that John Vick, Robert Ricks, Gilbert Vick and Ethelred C. Briggs any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal and real estate of John Demage dec^d in due equity to be assessed a shew and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of Jeremiah Cobb who stands with and together with Samuel Wilson, Melrose Briggs and John Boynton his decedent's executor and acknowledges debt in the sum of four thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Mary D. Demage dec^d on due bond.

Ordered that John Vick, Robert Ricks, Gilbert Vick and Ethelred C. Briggs any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose appraise all the personal estate of Mary D. Demage dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of Miles W. Lawrence. Ordered that Jesse Gardner, Samuel E. Moore and Jesse Cobb or any three of them being duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do view the ground along which the said Lawrence proposes to lay a road leading from Southway to Jerusalem commencing at the upper part of the said road and running nearly a straight course to the lower part thereof of the course and report to the Court the comparative convenience and inconvenience that will result from such individuals as to the public if such alteration be made as is proposed.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb examine State and settle John D. Hilditch of Wareham Westford and report the same to the Court with any matters connected therewith pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that Littleton R. Edwards examine State and settle Edward Hilditch of Wareham Westford and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Littleton R. Edwards examine State and settle William Hilditch of Wareham Westford of the estate of Henry Gurley decedent and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb examine State and settle in regard to the joint administration on Robert Jones estate and report the same to the Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

On motion of John W. Thomas. Ordered that he be exempt from the payment of fees for his slaves Gady and Pelly in future they being negroes.

On motion of David Poirer. Ordered that he be exempt from the payment of fees for his negro woman Pelly she being aged and infirm.
