The Court doth adjudge Jacob Williams guardian to Warren Williams orphan of Elizab't Williams deceased and therupon the said Jacob Williams with Isham Vick and Philip J. Blunt his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four hundred dollars conditioned according to Law.

The Court doth adjudge Williams A. Jones guardian to Martha H. Rebecca A. May & and Thomas B. Smith orphans of Thomas P. Smith deceased and therupon the said William A. Jones with Joseph T. Cland. Senior Westbrook and Sampson C. Pease his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of first thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

Maledict a negro woman Slave, the property of Thomas Newson of this County who stands charged with the murder of Allow a negro man the property of the said Thomas Newson on the 18th day of January last past, was this day set to the law in custody of the keeper of the jail of this County (the Court summoned for her trial having failed to meet) and being arraigned pleaded not guilty. Whereupon Sunday witness were sworn and examined and the prisoner fully heard in her defense by Robert Ridley esq; her Counsel. The Court after hearing the evidence and upon due consideration thereof and of all the circumstances of the case, are unanimously of opinion that she said Maledict is guilty of the murder aforesaid of which she stands charged, and it being demanded of her, if anything for herself she has or can say why the Court should not now proceed to pronounced judgment against her according to law, and nothing being offered or alleged in delay of judgment, it is considered by the Court that the said Maledict be hanged by the neck until she be dead, and that the Sheriff cause execution of this judgment to be done upon the body of the said Maledict on the 20th day of March next between the hours of 10 O'Clock A.M. and two O'Clock P.M. of that day. And the Court value the said Maledict to the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars. And the Court recommend to the Executive to commute the punishment of the said Maledict to transportation. And therupon she is sentenced to jail
