

A deed of Trust between Jonathan J Griffin of the first part William W Clark of the second part and Isadore Bassa of the third part was acknowledged by the parties thereto this 27th instant and recorded to be recorded.

A deed of bargain and sale between James Vick and Deborah his wife of the one part Gilbert Vick of the other part was acknowledged by the said James Vick who has signed and together with a certificate thereto annexed of the party examining the instrument of the style ordered to be recorded.

Louisa Simmons widow of Benjamin Simmons dec'd by her certificate relinquished her right to the administration of her said deceased husband's wife portion applying for the administration on said estate. It is ordered that the said Benjamin Simmons be committed to the hands of James D McFadden of this County for administration according to Law.

Ordered that Zebulon L Simmons, John Simmons, Joseph Drury and wife etc three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose all the personal estate of Benjamin Simmons dec'd be examined and return the appraisement to Court.

By motion of Sarah Briggs ordered that she be exempt from the payment of taxes for her Slave Luenda in future. She being informed.

Ordered that the estate of James Washington dec'd be committed to the hands of the Mecklenburg Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law.

This day came the parties by their Counsel and the Commissioners appointed by the decree made in this cause at Antrim Court 1838 to make division of the land mentioned this day made the following report. "The commissioners agreeable to the decree allotted unto the widow Priscilla Bryant widow of Britton Bryant dec'd and to her son of said dec'd husband Britton Bryant agreeable to the last of our judgment made at a Surp'ntial in Edwin Harris line, have drawn the line from south east through the lane near West to a small fence, a corner thence near South East to the head of the gum spring branch, thence down the said branch to James E. and Fred Brink to the Little Swamp, thence up the Little Swamp with all the land lying within bounds to the beginning, the remainder we suppose to be not worth \$100 per acre legate of the £200 left therefore we have not made a distribution for the same Given under our hands this 17th day of Feb 1840 Henry Hendrick Richard Peeler On consideration whereof it is decreed and ordered that
