Accounts of George H Gardner's guardianship of Elizabeth M. Isaac O. Leonard & and
Margaret A Gardner were returned and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the owners of the slaves for this County to the first
day of March next to consider of the propriety of having the trials in this County
postponed.

On the motion of John Hargrave for leave to open a new road on the line between himself and
Christian Jordan The Commissioners therefore appointed to view the ground along which such
road is proposed to be conducted this day made report which is ordered to be recorded and is in
these words to wit "In pursuance of the within order we the undersigned have viewed the
ground where the road is desired to be opened instead of the former or present road and
are unanimously of opinion that neither the publick or individual or individuals will
be at but little if very little inconveniences if the road be opened as desired by said John
Hargrave - Given under our hands this 1st day of March 1839 - Jacob Barnes,
W H Cutler, Nancy & Margaret Bergman Barnes On consideration whereof it is ordered
that leave be given the said John Hargrave to open the said road as proposed."

On the motion of Jacob Barnes for leave to turn the Bayside road near Marblehead The Commis-
sioners therefore appointed to view the way for altering said road this day made report
which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words to wit "Southampton County to wit. Per-
suant to the order within referred to we the undersigned have viewed the way proposed
by Jacob Barnes for altering a small portion of the publick road near Marblehead and are
as unanimously of opinion that little or no inconveniences will result to individuals and
as to the publick a convenience. Respectfully submitted to the County W H Cutler D W Bryant
Richd N Fergusson" On consideration whereof it is ordered that leave be given the said
Jacob Barnes to alter the said road as proposed.
