

adjudge, order and decree that James Magot, Mary Magot, and Thomas Everett or any two of them, be and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to make sale of said land after giving me in writing notice by advertising the day and place of sale at the Courthouse door and three other public places in the County of Southampton for approved bonds and security on six months credit and make distribution of the proceeds of the said sale after paying the expenses of this decree, affixing to the said Arthur Magot, Mary Battle and E. Carr in right of his child one third each of the proceeds of said sale and refer to the same in order to a final decree.

Alfred Stephenson is appointed Constable in the upper district of Notley Parish in the County to supply the vacancy created by the resignation of James E. Clayton. It appearing to the Court that the said Stephenson is a man of honest, orderly and good character and therefore he together with John Clark and Benjamin Goffin his Sureties executed and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned according to law which bond is ordered to be recorded. The said Alfred Stephenson took the several oaths required by law for his qualification.

This day came the parties by their counsel and the Commissioners appointed by the Intertreeing to make division of the lands of which Aaron Norfleet died deceased this day made the following report. Now, "Agreedly to the amount and decree of the unscrupulous Court of Southampton County to us directed. We the undersigned Commissioners as aforesaid in said decree in accordance to the requisitions thereof have proceeded to divide the lands of which Aaron Norfleet died deceased attended by Thomas W. Morrell as Surveyor, who found there to be in the whole eight Two hundred and Sixty Two acres, which we have described as follows containing there allotted to the widow Maria Norfleet sixteen acres and seven rods and fifteen poles, bounded Beginning at the flat swamp at a new corner for Lot No. 3, thence along a new line of marked trees S 29° 1/2 W 11.0 poles to a new corner for Lot 2 an Acre and Jones' land thence along said Acre Jones line S 67° E 30 poles to a walnut tree, thence S 41° E 31 poles to a post a new corner thence along a new line of marked trees N 67° 1/2 E 90 poles to a corner in Benjamin Waller's line, thence along his line to the run of the flat swamp thence up the run of said swamp to the beginning. - We have allotted to three youngest children Eveline, Adeline and Isom Norfleet the whole of the above described lands to have proportion therof at the decease of the testator. - We have also allotted to their Aunt Lucy Seven and half acres adjoining the said lower land, and the lands of Nath'l Jones and Ben' Waller which makes One hundred and four acres to be divided between them at the decease of the testator aforesaid which we consider to be their proportion in value of the total tract of land. the balance of the One hundred and forty eight acres we have divided as follows. Lot No. 1 containing fourteen half acres drawn by Angelina Norfleet and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a pine standing on the path near the School house in Nathaniel Jones' land a corner for the lands drawn by Ben' Brown, Jr., in right of his wife and others, thence along said Brown's line N 29° 1/2 E 53 poles to a post a corner for Lot No. 2 - thence along Lot No. 2 S 18° 1/2 E 38 poles to a corner for Lots No. 2 & 3. thence along same
