This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the Defendants  
have had legal notice of this trial they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is  
considered by the Court that the plaintiff may have execution against the Defendants for owing  
four dollars and eighty four cents the penalty of the said bond and the costs by sum about he  
mention in this behalf suspended. And the said Defendants are Money &c

But this execution may be discharged by the payment of thirty Seven Dollars forty Two cents  
with legal Interest thereon from the 17 day of January 1840 till paid and the costs.

On the motion of Augustin Pope administrator of Isaac Holt die<sup>d</sup>. Ordered that his  
administration account be recommitted to the Commissioner who reported it for him to examine  
and report therewith with any matter specially stated deemed pertinent by his self which  
he may be required to state.

On the motion of William D Hood administrator of Benjamin M Hancock die<sup>d</sup>. Ordered  
that he is bound in this Court as security for John D Worth for his due and faithful  
administration of the estate of Lewis N Branch die<sup>d</sup> and that he answers himself also  
danger of suffering damages by reason thereof and paying the Court for relief. It is ordered that  
the said John D Worth be summoned to the next Term to shew cause if any he can why he  
not be released to give the said Hood security as aforesaid good and sufficient security or release  
new bond with security according to Law.

It appears to the Court by the evidence of Jacob Barnes a credible witness that James Goss and  
Meldred his wife were married pursuant to the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1794. which is to  
be certified.

On the motion of Augustin Pope. Ordered that Jacob Barnes, Celibet Ellsworth and David  
Harrill or any two of them, who are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose shall  
and adjust an account of the said Pope's administration on David Hollis estate and make  
charge to Court.

On motion of John W Rockhill leave is hereby given him to close up the lot he  
owns between his lot and the Tenant of Sally Royal by a fence running in a straight  
line from any point on his own lot to some point opposite in the premises of Sally Royal.

On motion of Miss Jane Adole and for reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered  
the Overseer of the Poor or any two of them, bind two free boys named Sam and Tom  
to shepherd Jane Adole according to Law. That they covenant with the said Jane  
that she will pay to the master of the said children the following sums. That is to say  
one dollar per year for the three first years apprenticeship of the said children.
