This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the Defendants
have had legal notice of this motion they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it was
considered by the Court that the plaintiff may have execution against the Defendants for twenty
four dollars and eighty four cents the penalty of the said bond and the costs by him about the
motion are thus legally expended. And the said Defendants are Mordith &
But this execution may be discharged by the payment of thirty seven dollars forty two cents
with legal interest thereon from the 17 day of January 1840 till paid and the costs.

On the motion of Augustin Pope administrator of Jesse Holt dec^d. Ordered that his
administration account be recommended to the Commissioner who reported it for him to examine
and report thereupon with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by him self or which
he may be required to state.

On the motion of William D. Hood administrator of Maryann M. Hancock dec^d. leave
forth that he is bound in this Court as security for John D. North for his due and faithful
administration of the estate of Lewis M. Hancock dec^d and that he excuses himself on
danger of suffering damages by reason thereof and praying the Court for relief. It is ordered
that the said John D. North be summoned to the next Term to show cause if any he can why he
will be ruled to give the said Hood security as aforesaid good enough security a suitable
amount with security according to Law.

It appears to the Court by the evidence of Jacob Rames a credible witness that Lewis Rames
and Mildred his wife were married previous to the 1st day of January 1794, which is to

Merrill or any two of them, who are hereby appointed Commissioners in the process before
and adjust an account of the said Pope's administration on David Holt's estate and make
report to Court.

On motion of John W. Richelle leave is hereby given him to close up the estate
some between his lot and the Government of Sally Royal by a fence running from a point
from any point on his new lot to some point opposite to the premises of Sally Royal.

On motion of Mrs Jane Bonds and for reasons appearing to the Court. It is ordered
that the Owners of the Dorr or any two of them, bind two free boys named Daniel and William
to support Jane Bonds according to Law. That they covenant with the said Jane Bonds
that she will pay to the mother of the said children the following sums, that is to say
five dollars per year for the three first years apprenticeship of the said Daniel and
