

The death of William D Hodges esquire having been announced, the following resolution was offered by Samuel J Douglass Esq:

Resolved, that we have heard with the most unfeigned sorrow and the deepest regret the news of William D Hodges Esq: a member of this bar.

Resolved, that in this disposition of Providence this bar has lost an able member - the truly one of her most talented sons, and surely one of its brightest ornaments -

Resolved, that in testimony of our profound regret, and as evidence of the high regard in which the deceased was held, the members of the Court, Bar, and the Officers of this Court wear the usual badge of mourning for the space of thirty days -

Ordered, that the proceedings be spread on the record, and a copy be forwarded by the Clerk to Hon: P H Baker Esq: a relative of the deceased.

Resolved, that the Editor of the Richmond, Norfolk and Petersburg papers, be furnished with a copy of these resolutions and requested to publish them -

Pursuant to the Act of Assembly the Court doth order and direct that for the purpose of prescripining the lands in the County the same be divided into 39 parcels as follows:

Precent No. 1. From Nottoway river up the great swamp to Brafford's road, down the said road to Nottoway river and down the said river to the beginning -

No. 2. From the north side of the flat swamp from the old parish line, thence the cabin branch and up that to the Angelica swamp, up the same to Robins branch and up that to the flat swamp and down the said flat swamp -

No. 3. Bounded by the Meherrin river and the flat swamp and from the old parish line to the flat swamp and so up to Thomas' Rocks -

No. 4. Between Nottoway river, Bangs bridge road, the three creeks and the Bedford river -

No. 5. All the lands lying east of the Buckhorn swamp, Nottoway River, the Indian line and the main road sometimes called the creek road -

No. 6. From the Angelica swamp bridge up the swamp to Townsend branch, thence the branch to the Angelica Branch, then down Barnes road to the head of Buckhorn River to the main road and by the said road to the beginning -

No. 7. From the mouth of Hilding's branch to the head of George's branch, down that to Rose meadow, up that to Robins branch, up that to the head of the Angelica swamp and down the said swamp to the beginning -

No. 8. From Robins branch up the south side of the three creeks to the Indian line, the Meherrin river, down the said river to Thomas' Rocks land and thence to Robins branch -

No. 9. From the former parish line down the flat swamp to Brafford's road and up the said road to the County line and up the said line to the Greenville line, up that to the old parish line and along the said line to the beginning -

No. 10. From Brafford's road down the flat swamp to the County line, thence the said road to the beginning -

No. 11. From the mouth of Robins swamp to the mouth of Rose swamp up that to the Indian line, down the said line to Brafford's road, up the said road to the old parish line and up the same to the beginning -

No. 12. From the Parish line at the flat swamp down the said swamp to the mouth of Robins swamp, up the same to the mouth of Rose swamp up that to the Indian line -
