

The death of William D. Hodges square having been announced, the following resolutions were offered by Samuel J. Douglas Esq.

Resolved, that we have heard with the most unfeigned sorrow and the deepest regret the death of William D. Hodges Esq. a member of this bar.

Resolved, that in this dispensation of Providence this bar has lost an able member - the country one of her most talented sons, and society one of its brightest ornaments.

Resolved, that in testimony of our profound regret, and as evidence of the high regard in which the deceased was held, the members of the Court bar, and the Officers of this Court wear the usual badge of mourning for the space of thirty days.

Ordered, that the proceedings be spread on the record, and a copy be forwarded by the Clerk to Mrs. R. H. Parker Esq. a relative of the deceased.

Resolved, that the Editors of the Richmond, Norfolk and Petersburg papers, be furnished with a copy of these resolutions and requested to publish them.

Pursuant to the Act of Assembly the Court doth order and direct that for the purpose of partitioning the lands in the County the same be divided into 29 parcels as follows to-wit:

N^o 1. From Nottoway river up the great swamp to Craffords road down the road to Nottoway river and down the said river to the beginning.

N^o 2. From the north side of the flat swamp from the old span to lane, thence to the cabin branch and up that to the Angelica swamp, up the same to Rivers branch and up that to the flat swamp and down the said flat swamp.

N^o 3. Bounded by the Meherrin river and the flat swamp and from the old parish line to the flat swamp and so up to Thomas Creek.

N^o 4. Between Nottoway river, Gaug bridge road, the three creeks and the Deepford river.

N^o 5. All the lands lying east of the Duckhorn swamp, Nottoway River, the Indian line and the main road. Sometimes called the creek road.

N^o 6. From the Angelica swamp bridge, up the swamp to Townsend branch, up the old branch to the Angelica Whipple, then down Rivers road to the head of Duckhorn dam to the new road and by the said road to the beginning.

N^o 7. From the mouth of Ridleys branch to the head of Georges branch, down that to Ross meadow, up that to Rivers branch, up that to the head of the Angelica swamp and down the said swamp to the beginning.

N^o 8. From Rivers branch up the south side of the three creeks to the beginning line to the Meherrin river, down the said river to Thomas Creek's land and thence to Rivers branch.

N^o 9. From the former parcels line down the flat swamp to Craffords road and along the said road to the County line, and up the said line to the Greenville line, up that to the old parish line and along the said line to the beginning.

N^o 10. From Craffords road down the flat swamp to the County line, Craffords road along the said road to the beginning.

N^o 11. From the mouth of Blunts swamp to the mouth of Ross swamp, up that to the Indian line, down the said line to Craffords road, up the said road to the old parish line and up the same to the beginning.

N^o 12. From the parish line at the flat swamp down the said swamp to the mouth of Blunts swamp, up the same to the mouth of Ross swamp, up that to the Indian line.
