This day came the parties by their counsel and the commissioners appointed by the interlocutory decree in this cause to make sale of the tract of land therein mentioned, this day made a report which is ordered to be recorded and is in these words, to wit: "Agreeable to the directions of the within decree we have executed a deed to Clements Rockwell the purchaser of the lands and taken six bonds as directed (Copper paying all costs) which bonds we have paid to the second legatee whose receipts are hereto filed, which is respectfully submitted to the Court. Deffe Drury James Magot, Eliah Colwell." On consideration whereof and by consent it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form as aforesaid made be held firm and stable and binding between the parties forever.

On the motion of John Gooding who produced the Sheriff's receipt for the tax imposed by law and with Elias Wick his security entered into and acknowledged a bond on the penalty of One hundred and fifty dollars conditioned as the law directs, a license is granted him to keep an Ordinary at Franklin in this County till May Court next. It appearing to the Court that the said John Gooding is a man of good character and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming.

Robert Worngren for Charles H Child having obtained an attachment against the estate of George W Small John has removed and absconded and conceals himself so that the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon him, for the sum of eighty six dollars and seventeen cents with interest thereon from the 19th day of April 1829 till paid, and the Sheriff having made return that he had attached three large boxes, and one large trundle, supposed to contain bed and bed clothing. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant not appearing to reply to the said attached effects, on the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney and for reasons appearing to the Court the said attachment is continued till the next Court.

An Inventory and appraisement of Thomas Barnes estate was returned and ordered to be recorded.

Ann Eliza Selles orphan of Benjamin Selles deceased with the approbation of the Court made choice of Zachariah Scarborough father guardian who together with Jacobus C Selles and husband Selles his security entered into and acknowledged a bond on the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

On the motion of Richard Drury and Marston his wife to establish the testamentary will of Gabriel Soyner dec'd. Ordered that Julia Soyner, the wife of the said Gabriel be summoned to the next Court to contest the same.

Allen Edwards, James W Musfee and Jordan Edwards are appointed Overseers of the Poor in the lower district of Newbury Parish.
John Rayburn, William Wood and Richard A Wells are appointed Overseers of the Poor in
