This day this cause came on to be heard on the bill and answer, was debated by counsel and argued by Counsel. Whereupon the Court with a Judge, order and decree that the tract of land claimed in the bill it being the land of Richard Halecomb dec^d, be divided into two equal parts regard being had to value, and that $\frac{3}{4}$ parts be allotted to Richard Halecomb as the following rights - one sixth part in his own right as heir of his father Richard Halecomb dec^d, $\frac{1}{6}$ part as devise of his deceased sister Anne Halecomb and $\frac{1}{6}$ as devise of his mother, it being one half their interest devised to him and his brother Edmund. That they allot and set apart to John Drake who was purchaser of Ebenezer Cobb who was purchaser of Edmund Halecomb $\frac{3}{4}$ of the following rights - one sixth which the said Edmund inherited as heir of his deceased father and $\frac{1}{6}$ which he holds as devise of his mother and that they allot to James Holt the other sixth which he claims as purchaser of Peggy Halecomb who inherited the same from her deceased father. And that Thomas C Davis, James Schell, William J Schell and William Brown be appointed Commissioners, any three of whom may act, who with the County Surveyor shall divide the land in the proportions above stated and allot them to the before named parties, and shall report to this Court the manner in which they have executed the same in order to a final decree. It is further ordered that the costs & expenses of this suit be paid equally by the parties.
