This day this cause came on to be heard on the bill and answer, was argued by counsel and argued by Counsel. Whereupon the Court did adjudge, order and decree that the tract of land named in the bill, & being the land of Richard Haleomb deceased be divided into two equal parts regard being had to value, and that $\frac{1}{2}$ parts be allotted to Richard Haleomb in the following rights - one sixth part in his own right as heir of his father Richard Haleomb deceased $\frac{1}{2}$ part as devise of his deceased Sister Anne Haleomb and $\frac{1}{2}$ as devise of his mother, & being in half of her interest devised to him and his brother Edmund - That they allot and set apart to John Drake who was purchaser of Jere Cobb who was purchaser of Edmund Haleomb $\frac{1}{2}$ in the following rights - one sixth which she said Edmund inherited as heir of his deceased father and $\frac{1}{2}$ which he holds as devise of his mother and that they allot to James Holt the other sixth which he claims as purchaser of Peggy Haleomb who inherited the same from her deceased father. And that Thomas C Davis, James Hobell, William J Hobell and William Rivers be appointed Commissioners, any three of whom may sit, who with the County Surveyor shall divide the land in the proportions above stated and allot them to the before named parties - and shall report to this Court the manner in which they have executed the same in order to a final decree. It is further ordered that the costs & expenses of this suit be paid equally by the parties -
