Ordered that George Gay render before Master Commissioner Briggs on account of his transactions as guardian of Elizabeth Washington (now Elizabeth Powell) and that the said Commissioner examine State and settle the same and make report thereof to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Elizabeth Adams is appointed Surveyor of the road from the fork of the Petersburg and Smithfield roads to Wicksville in the room of John S. Deale dec<sup>d</sup>. And it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

A Deed of Benjamin Dale from Benjamin W. Deale to William Harrison was acknowledged by the said Benjamin W. Deale to be his act and Deed and ordered to be recorded.

The last Will and Testament of Elizabeth Adams dec<sup>d</sup> was proved by the oath of William Perkins and Peter D. Dickson two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.
