the County and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Howell Harris who made oath and together with James Harris and John  
Dowry his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred  
dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of adminis-  
tration on the estate of Charles Newton deceased in due form.

Ordered that William A Jones, John Lucy, George Newton and Thomas Turner or any  
three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appre-  
aise all the personal estate of Charles Newton deceased and return the appraisement  
under their hands to Court.

On the motion of Benjamin Griffin who made oath and together with Robert G Griffin  
and Abigail Bradshaw his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the pen-  
alty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him  
for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Edith Bradshaw dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Richard Brandy, Robert G Griffin and Abigail Bradshaw being  
first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the  
personal estate of Edith Bradshaw dec'd and return the appraisement under their  
hands to Court.

Jonathan Douth is appointed Surveyor of the road from the state line to the iron bridge  
across Allens Mill pond, and it is ordered that the hands of Henry Britty, Sam-  
uel Williams, John Hart, Orman Bryant and his wife do work thereon.

William Owens is appointed Surveyor of the road from the sign post near his house to  
the state line near Abraham R. Licks and it is ordered that the hands of Catharine  
Howard, Leonard Cobb and his wife do work thereon.

Ordered, that the Court be adjourned till the morrow morning Nine O'Clock.
