Ordered that David Rogers, John W. Galey and Littleton R. Edwards or any two of them, examine state and settle the account of James D. Maysburg Sheriff of the County and make report thereof to Court.

On the motion of Howell Harris who made oath and together with James Harris and Jesse Drowry has been sworn entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Charles Newton deceased in due form.

Ordered that William A. Jones, John Dwy, Jesse Newton and Thomas Tenney or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Charles Newton deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of Benjamin Griffin who made oath and together with Robert S. Griffin and Abigail Bradshaw has been sworn entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Edith Bradshaw dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Richard Branch, Robert S. Griffin and William Bradshaw being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Edith Bradshaw dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Amathus North is appointed Surveyor of the road from the State line to the bear creek bridge across Allens Mill pond, and it is ordered that the hands of Henry North, Samuel Williams, John Hart, Orman Bryant and his own do work thereon.

William Orms is appointed Surveyor of the road from the sign post near his house to the State line near Abrahams R. ditches and it is ordered that the hands of Ethelred Hanns, Leonard Cobb and his own do work thereon.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the morrow morning nine o'clock. The minutes of the foregoing proceedings were signed by Elias Myrick.
