Benjamin J. Barrell, Henry Hendrick, Richard J. Barday & Thomas Pethman and Richard Darder
his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of forty thousand dollars conditioned as
the law directs, certificate is granted him for drawing a probate of the said will in due form

Ordered that John C. Peale, Thomas W. Herrell, Henry Blow and Archibald Vick or any three of them
being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose to appraise all the personal
and real estate of James Stephenson deceased within this County which may be to them produced or shown and
return the appraisement under their hands to Court

The last Will and Testament of Willie Francis deceased was proved by the oaths of Henry Morris and Samuel
W. Headard two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded, and on the motion of Amos
Harris one of the executors therein named who made oath and together with Nathan A. Thomas and
Richard Parker his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of thirty thousand dollars
conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for drawing a probate thereof in due form being
subject to the other executors therein named to be joined in the said probate when they think fit.

Ordered that Nathaniel Francis, Henry Moore, Peter Edwards and James Jackson or any
three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose to appraise all
the personal estate of Willie Francis deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court

Harrison Parker an infant of tender years by Hennings J. Smith his guardian just friend
against Hennings J. Smith administrator of Maria Parker deceased and Godwin Parker his son
Holly Parker his grandchild and next friend

This day this court was debked by consent, came on to debate and was argued & decided
thereupon the following decree, order and decree that H. H. Scott and Epes Parker be appointed Commissioners
of this Court to take, settle and adjust the transactions of Hennings J. Smith, Matthew H. Vaughan and H. H.
Scott executors of Harrison Parker deceased. That the said Commissioners make a just settlement among
the distributees share of Harrison Parker (an infant born after the death of his father and not surviving)
under his will in the personal estate. That the said Commissioners also take an account of the value of his
real estate of which said Harrison Parker died seized in his minority and then the distributees shall
be paid out of the same. The said Commissioners shall in making up and account all to Godwin Parker
therefore by the name of Harry specifically named to him by his father out of his estate, his
estate and the share of Harrison Parker equal in value to say as at the time of his father's death
and any other things and matters deemed pertinent, all of which they shall report to the Court
