Ordered that the estate of Fainly Lister die^d be committed to the hands of Thomas Proctor Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.

Ordered that the estate of Dorothy A. Brown die^d be committed to the hands of Thomas Proctor Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.

Hovell Edmunds the executor named in the last Will and Testament of Archibald Edmunds late before recorded in this Court, this day appeared in Court and took the oaths prescribed by law and with John M. Gandy and Arthur B.
