

your said Estate in this County on the 27th day of February 1860. Which is ordered to be certified.

It appears to the Court from satisfactory evidence that Elias Love who was a Revolutionary Pensioner of the United States died in this County on the 17th day of September 1856, leaving Elizabeth Brown a daughter living in this County. That many years previous to the death of the said Elias Love all his other children removed to the West. That since his death the children who had remained have been unwilling and other efforts made to ascertain their residence but without success, and that they have not been heard of within the last twelve months. That the said Elias left no widow.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
