

This Court certifies that satisfactory evidence was introduced showing that Henry Love a Revolutionary pensioner of the United States at the rate of \$300 per year died on the 27th day of February 1840 that he resided in this County at the time of his death and that he left no widow child or children.

Hammie and Alexander Myrick his descendants entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Daniel R. Bulle deceased in due form.

Ordered that Henry Peltway, Barbara Moore, Samuel Braham and Joseph Stanton or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Daniel R. Bulle deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

The court doth adjudge Thomas P. Hammie guardian to Lucy Ann Bulle widow of Daniel R. Bulle deceased, and therupon the said Thomas P. Hammie with John W. Hammie and Alexander Myrick his descendants entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars with condition according to law.

On the motion of William A. Jones who made oath and with Peter Edwards and John A. Personas his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Nancy B. Smith deceased in due form.

Ordered that Henry Moore, David Stevens, Peter Edwards and James Jones or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Nancy B. Smith deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Lithgow R. Edwards Clerk of this Court with Edwards Bulles his security entered into bond for the payment of the bonds and other public monies which may come to his hands which bond was acknowledged by the obligors therein named and ordered to be recorded.
