

At a Court of Oyer and Terminer, summoned and held for the County of Southampton on Wednesday the 2^d day of September 1840, pursuant to a warrant issued by Jeremiah Cobb a Justice for said County for the trial of Archelus a slave belonging to the estate of Nathaniel Bangell, late of the County of Sussex - Daniel the property of Nathaniel D. Land, dec^d of the same County and Nelson the property of Peter Raths estate of the County of Southampton for following at Danvers meeting house in the said County on Sunday 23^d day of August last past, rebellion, insurrection and treason against the citizens of this Commonwealth.

The Court being thus constituted the prisoners Archelus, Daniel and Nelson were set in the lawful custody of the Jailor of this County. Whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that the warrant under which this Court was summoned be quashed and that the said prisoners be taken by the Sheriff before some Justice of the Peace for this County to be dealt with according to law.

The Court being thus constituted the said Day, Solomon and Abram were set in the lawful custody of the Jailor of this County. Whereupon for reasons appearing to the Court it is ordered that the warrant under which this Court was summoned be quashed and that the said prisoners be taken by the Sheriff before some Justice of the Peace for this County to be dealt with according to law. Ordered that the Jailor summon a guard consisting of six effective men to guard the Jail of this County during the confinement of prisoners therein charged with insurrection or rebellion or until the further order of the Court.
