

At a Court held for the County, of Southampton on the 28th day of September 1840.

This Court this day returned a list of the deeds admitted to record in the Clerk's Office since August Term including those admitted to record during the said Term, which last being inspected by the Court it ordered to be inserted among the minutes of the proceedings of the day and is as follows.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from William Bardon and Mary his wife to Thomas Curwitt conveying a tract of 120 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 16th August 1840 and together with the certificate annexed of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from John M. Dudley and Lucy his wife to James Story conveying a tract of 50 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Office on the 19th May 1840 by two other witnesses was together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Jesse Ferguson and Lucy his wife to John E. Drake conveying a tract of 777 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the said Office on the 31st March 1835 by two other witnesses was together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Gift from James D. Dand to John Melles conveying a life right in 50 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of August 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Edwin Loughrey and Josephine his wife to Eliza Bardon conveying a tract of 125 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from John Lewis and Catharine his wife to William Davis conveying a tract of 6 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and together with the certificate annexed of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Avert Bramble of the first part Alfred J. Stephenson of the second part and William D. Hood attorney of Benjamin A. Hancock dec^d and in his own right conveying a tract of 1672 acres of land was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Richard Harris of the first part, William D. Clarke of the second part and Martin Taylor of the third part conveying a tract of 500 acres of land was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between John A. Turner of the first part Anthony A. Williams of the second part and Sam. Jay and James D. Westbrooke of the third part conveying four slaves, Phoebe, Fanny, Dick and Phil was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Joseph O. Ferguson of the first part Isaac Worrell of the second part and John Darrell of the third part conveying all his interest in the lands and slaves of Dixon Ferguson estate was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from James M. Drake to Oliver Waller conveying a tract of 500 acres of land and two slaves Fanny and Betty was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the
