Deed of Bargain and Sale from William Parker and Mary his wife to Thomas Cowell conveying a tract of 120 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 14th August 1840 and together with the certificate annexed of the proxy examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from John M. Dudley and Lucy his wife to James Foy conveying a tract of 50 acres of land was proved in the Clerks on the 17th August 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Office on the 19th May 1840 by two other witnesses was together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from John Ferguson and Lucy his wife to John E. Darley conveying a tract of 77 acres of land was proved in the Clerks Office on the 17th August 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the said Office on the 21st March 1840 by two other witnesses was together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Gift from James H. Pond to Ira Helms conveying a life right in 50 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 17th day of August 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Edwin Daugherty and Temperance his wife to Eliza Parker conveying a tract of 125 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 17th August 1840 and together with the certificate annexed of the proxy examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Trust Persons of the first part Alfred J. Stephenson of the same part and William D. Head owner of Burrough & Hancock Esq^r and in his own right conveying a tract of 167 1/2 acres of land was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerks Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Richard Harris of the first part, William D. Clarke of the second part

and Walter Taylor of the third part conveying a tract of 300 acres of land was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerks Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Edward J. Turner of the first part Anthony A. Williams of the second part and Peter Long and James D. Whistlock of the third part conveying four Slaves, Phatia, Tom, Dick and Phil was acknowledged by the parties in the Clerks Office the 17th August 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Joseph S. Ferguson of the first part, Joseph Worrell of the second part and John Barrett of the third part, conveying all his interest in the lands and slaves of Dixon Ferguson estate was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 17th August 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from James H. Read to Edwin Waller conveying a tract of 400 acres of land and two Slaves, Jimmy and Betty was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the
